AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 513 – UNIFORM BUILDING CODE OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF LIMON ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 371 RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, ABATEMENT, MAINTENANCE, ENERGY USE, ACCESSIBILITY AND FIRE PROTECTION OF
